Welcome to the 2018 CUB FRESHMAN Volleyball Invitational. The first round will begin at 8:30 A.M. Saturday, September 29. Courts will be open at 8:00 a.m. Teams will be given a full 17-minute (5-6-6) warm up for their first match of the day. After the second round, a 6-minute warm up will precede each match -- 3 minutes for each team. This is a 9-team tournament, with three pools of three; all teams are guaranteed four matches.

Game Site: Nevada High School. We will be using two courts on the main fieldhouse floor and one court in the South High School Gym.

Format: All matches will be 2 out of 3 format, rally score to 21, no caps. Third games will be rally scoring to 15, no caps.

Pool Play: Each team will play the other two teams in their pool; all teams will play two matches in this round.

Championship & Consolation Rounds: Each team will advance to play in the championship and consolation rounds, according to the criteria listed below. All teams will play two matches in this round.

Medals: 15 Medals for the Championship Winning Team

Line Judges/Trackers/Scorebook/Scoreboard: Teams not playing will need to supply five people: two to line judge, one to provide libero tracker, one for the official scorebook and one to run the scoreboard on their pool court. The only exception will be the final round of the day, in which the teams participating will both have to supply 2 or 3 people.

Entry Fee: \$50.00. Please send to the Athletic Director at Nevada High School

Admission: Admission for the general public is \$5.00 for all day

Valuables: Each team is responsible for their own valuables, clothes, and personal possessions, whether in a gym or in a "camp."

Warm-up balls: Provided by Nevada

Warm-ups: There will be a 17-minute warm-up before each team's first match of the day. Following the second round, there will only be a 6-minute warm up.

Concessions: The concession stand will be open for the entire tournament.

Pool and Playoff Criteria: The first place teams from each pool will advance to the championship play. The second place teams from each pool will advance to play each other, and the third place teams will advance to play each other. The number of matches won will determine place finishes in the pools. If a tie exists, the following criteria will be used to break the tie in all pool play. If there are more than two teams tied, we will use criteria to seed the top team, then go back to the criteria and follow the process again.
